MARIA

LEAF
No running no swimming no climbing... anything. No objects in the mouth or electrical sockets no messing with fire stay away from stray animals cleaning solutions people with flu-like symptoms and homemade baked goods.

MARIA
Good, good. Okay, time to go. END
